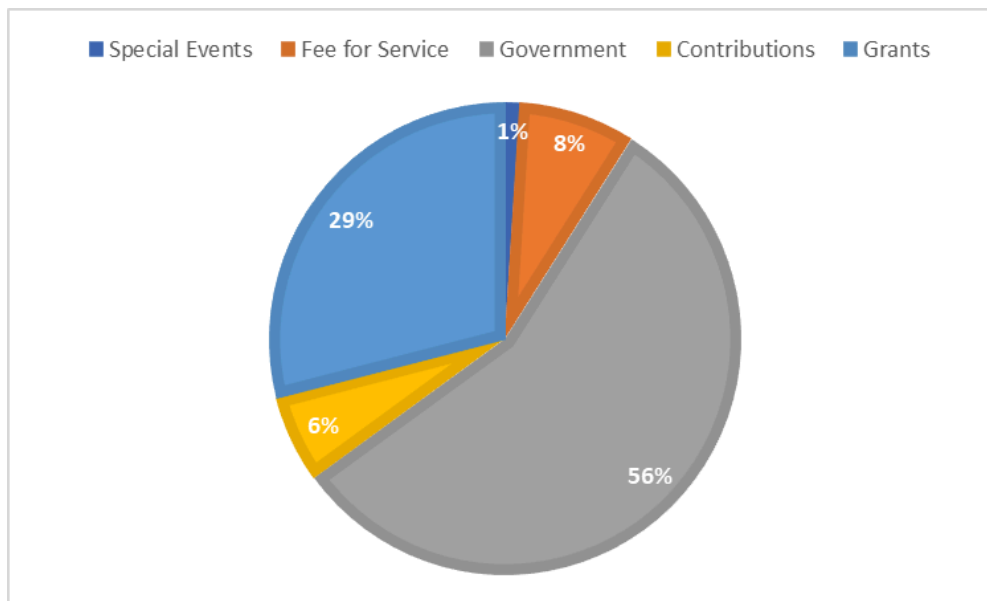

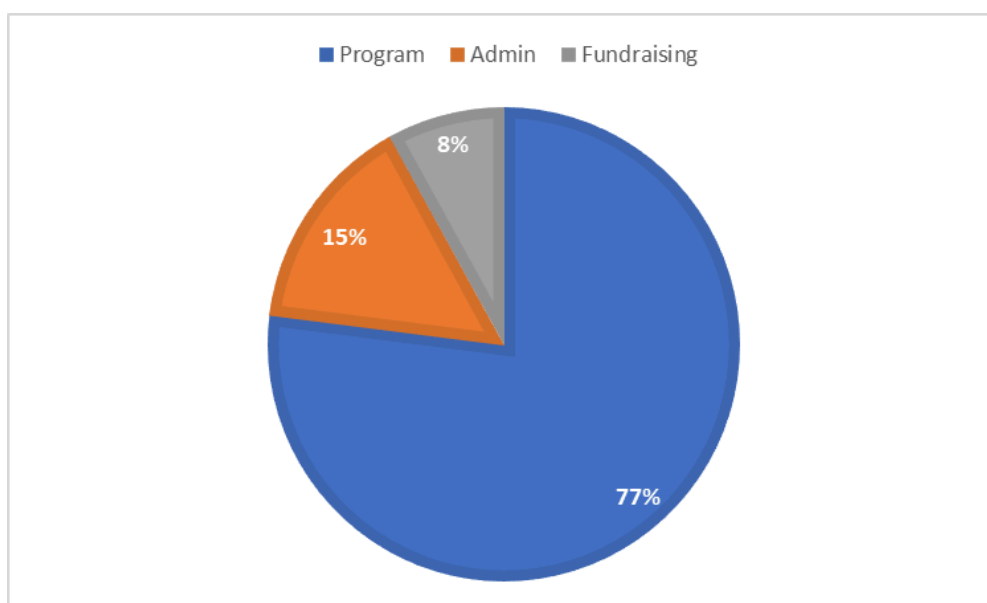
Financial Summary
